## Safe Places to Stay

### 1. Denver Rescue Mission (also known as 'Jesus Saves'):

All guests must sign up at the Lawrence Street Community Center to be entered into the bed assignment system. Men only.

### 2. Salvation Army Denver: 1901 29TH St., Denver

Provides emergency overnight shelter for men. Shelter offers: Dinner and breakfast, Showers, Laundry, Lockers, and Kennels for dogs, based on availability. Beds distributed at 12 noon on a first-come first-serve basis. Weekly rental available.

### 3. Delores Project: Denver | 303-534-5411 | <https://thedeloresproject.org/emergency-shelter>

Extended-stay shelter for women, transgender, and nonbinary individuals. Call daily at 10am to inquire about bed availability and complete a brief phone screen.

Meals, hygiene items, and seasonal clothing available. Showers available. Call 5 am – 12 pm on the last day of the month to get on the list for a bed. Call after 2 pm to confirm your spot. Monthly stays begin on the first day of each month.
