Warmlines

A warmline is a phone number you call to have a conversation with someone who can provide support during hard times. Warmlines is free and confidential. It is different from crisis lines or hotlines, which are more focused on keeping you safe in the moment and getting you connected to crisis resources as quickly as possible. (That doesn't mean you can't call a warmline when you're in crisis—a warmline may even be able to help you find the best place to go for crisis resources, or help you mentally prepare to seek out more formal treatment.)
